### Instructions:

1. Number the measures in the pieces you are performing.
2. Photocopied music is NOT allowed.
3. Fill out the comment sheet provided by your teacher.
4. **Remember to bring your music and comment sheet.**
5. Arrive at least 20 minutes before your scheduled time.
6. Parking is not available in the music building lot except for Duke employees with passes. You may park across the street at Asbury Methodist Church or on the street. You may also park in any un-gated area on the Duke East Campus as long as it is not a fire, service or handicap zone.
7. **ALL students** check in at the front desk.
8. You may leave after playing and getting your music back. Your certificate and comment sheet will be given to your teacher at the end of the day.
9. Two **Honors Recitals** will be held Sunday afternoon, May 20, in **Nelson Music Room, located 1<sup>st</sup> building on right off Main St. Music Room is 2<sup>nd</sup> floor.**
  - **4:00 First recital** – Solo winners ages 12-13, 14-15, Young Artist 13-15, 5-8 recitalists, Nakarai Winner, (and possibly duets)
  - **5:30 Second recital** – Solo winners age 16+, some duets and ensembles, Young Artist 16+, Jazz, 9-11 & OB recitalists
  - If you are a 1<sup>st</sup> place winner or a “recitalist,” your teacher will tell you in which recital you are playing.
  - All students receiving an award are encouraged to be present to be acknowledged during the recital.
10. Parking for Honors Recitals is available on street by the Nelson Music Room building off Main St.
